



The steel house structure for the Arcade has been completed, the Arcade will be installed and ready to shoot real soon if not already done by the time this newsletter makes it to your mailbox. While on this subject I would like to remind all members to **ONLY** shoot your paper targets from strait in front of them. There are dozens of bullet holes in the side of the new steel house structure from members cross shooting at targets. **STOP!** This structure was not easy to build, cost a lot of money and needs to last. If you want to shoot a 15 yard target, move over in front of the 15 yard target frames, don't shoot from in front of the 10 yard target frame. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

A quick reminder, there are also 10,15, and 25 yard target frames on A-2 range. The B range is by far the most popular range at TRPC, it is also where the plate rack and new Arcade are located. REMEMBER to share this range with other members, if they want to go down range to shoot steel. Don't forget there is NO handling of firearms when people are down range. This is why the additional target frames were added to A-2 range. Now there are 2 ranges with 10,15 & 25 yard target frames and only 1 range with a plate rack & Arcade to shoot.

TRPC Sporting Clays Fall Fun Shoot

Sporting Clays has begun our 2019/20 season at TRPC. Your club hosted a Sporting Clays event on Saturday, December 7 with a great turnout and wonderful weather. In total, 42 shooters participated. This event raised over \$500 for our junior programs. As always, there was an entertaining course of fire, great food, and plenty of fun and fellowship.

TRPC member Dr. Jeff Snyder was the top prize winner of the event, turning in a great score of 39 of 50 targets broken. Dr. Snyder is a fine shot and showed it by achieving the high score of the day with a diminutive 28 gauge! Second and third prizes were also awarded.

The course consisted of 10 stations, or shooting locations. Five targets were thrown from each in the following order: a single target, a report pair of targets where a single target is thrown and a second follows upon the report of the gun, and finally a true pair, or two targets thrown simultaneously. Targets varied in size, speed and direction. Shooters are given some challenging presentations by using remote target throwers. These can be placed several hundred feet from the shooter and brings additional challenges and fun to the event.

Over 180 individuals have participated in Sporting Clays at TRPC since it re-emerged in 2015. The event continues to attract new shooters, including juniors. The event has a devoted core of regulars, many of whom rarely miss an event. TRPC recognizes member Bruce Rutledge who has participated in every event since December 2015!

Only 2 squads can be on the course simultaneously, so squadding is imperative for the event to function. Participants can "pre-squad" by notifying the match director, and are given a reporting time. Shooting the course takes about an hour per squad. Participants can shoot as many times as they wish, and some shooters enjoy trying the course again.

Lunch was included in the entry fee and consisted of delicious pork ribs, BBQ chicken, baked beans, chili, slaw, mac and cheese, chips and drinks. Many thanks to John Schmidt and Craig Carson for delicious food; and a huge shoutout to Jim Hines for doing the BBQ. Jim's cooking is one the reasons the event is so well attended.

Our warmest thanks to the TRPC members who contributed to making the event so successful; Hugh Salter, Larry Nelson, Jim Hines, Gary Rickard, John Schmidt, Mark Butsch, Aaron Cohen, Randy Miller, Kirt Armantrout, Henry Gainer, and especially Andy Randall.
