



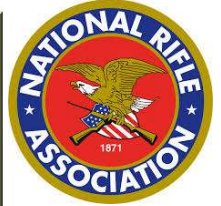

PRESIDENT'S PAGE

First, let me ramble a bit about safety. TRPC Range Safety Rule 18. Make sure that any shot fired hits the backstop. Never fire into the side berms.

All shots fired at TRPC must go into their respective backstops. For all ranges except shotgun, that's the downrange berm which is perpendicular to the shooting positions. The elevation of the shooter and target both must be accounted for. You must adjust your position or target height so that the projectile goes through the target and impacts directly in the backstop. Shooting at a target that is too low will cause the bullet to ricochet off the ground, and skip over the backstop leaving the range. Shooting from a low position into a high target could cause the bullet to go over the backstop and leave the range. Use only the provided target stands or equivalent and approved targets. Please take a few seconds when setting up and verify that your bullets will impact the backstop.

Secondly, please consider volunteering for our youth program on the second Saturday of each month. We have been averaging about 11 participants with about 7 who have worked up to the advanced level. This program works best with 6-8 volunteers. This gives us ample members to instruct/coach, perform safety officer duties, and keep up the paperwork. Drop me an email and I will include you in the monthly reminder I send out. Remember this important program helps to bring new members to our sport and hopefully keeps the Second Amendment safe for future generations.
