





New fence line/perimeter – Team Leader Fleming

Materials needed: high lift jack or improvise with 2x4s and a metal rod. Remove old “NO TRESPASSING” signs and posts. Store posts adjacent to BoD conex. Install new “NO TRESPASSING” signs along fence perimeter. Materials provided.
