



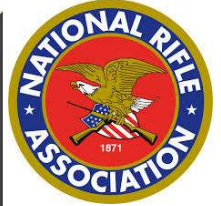

## JANUARY 31, 2026 WORKDAY PLAN

A regular 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday work day will be held JANUARY 31st. We'll continue to maintain our range and get some small projects accomplished.

Bring your yard care tools (brush trimmers, limb loppers, rakes, edgers, blowers, string trimmers, etc.) Also remember that proper gear including gloves and good eye protection is just as important when working with power tools and clearing brush. Prepare accordingly.

Rake and remove brush from around buildings, structures and storage in preparation for a controlled burn. Clear straw, leaves and brush to 5' away. Remove straw and leaves from roofs or shelters. Remember Cowboy Town and the various wood structures there.

Pick up brush, limbs etc. across the range and pile up in waste areas. Clear brush from beneath benches all ranges.

Weedeat around concrete, trees, signage, etc. Blow all concrete shooting areas.

Pick up trash. Empty all trash cans.

Clear roofs and surroundings of all structures of brush and privet, weeds, etc. for fire protection.

Clean up clubhouse and clean toilets. Restock with supplies.

Ranges A2 and B – replace coroplast target backers with new. Remove brush and dead wood A1 and B.

Range G – usual lawn work and pick up wads. Blow off roof of conex.

Bring appropriate work clothes, eye and ear protection, gloves. Water and sports drinks will be provided.

We are in need of tractor work. If you want to volunteer your time and equipment, and have either a 5'/6' harrow or a box blade we can use you! Members donating time and tractor work will have ALL dues waved for 2026/2027. Please call Kevin Fleming at 850-509-9569 prior to work day.

## Proposed Dues Increase

**Board of Directors Tallahassee Rifle & Pistol Club, Inc.**

**November 15, 2025**

**Board Action #2025.11.15**

***The Tallahassee Rifle and Pistol Club Board of Directors propose, the following action in regards to the TRPC Standing Rules: Amending Tallahassee Rifle & Pistol Club Standing Rules to reflect an increase of the annual dues from \$180.00 to \$210.00.***

The above board action will be up for vote at the January 10, 2026, General Membership Meeting. Below is the excerpt from the Standing Rules that will be affected by the proposed increase. Also, highlighted are 3 house keeping changes to reflect current practices of TRPC. We no longer have a Members Only section on the web site. Workday credits are currently being awarded for 2 hours of range service (currently reflects 4 hours) and the rewording prorated dues for new members.

2. Regular membership fees are **\$210.00 per year.** (01/2026)

• Members will receive an \$80.00 credit for providing **2 hours** of range service.(01/2026)

• Range service hours must be provided at a Workday or approved by the Board of Directors. • See Range Service Policy. ~~or TRPC Website. Members Only Section, Club Policies.~~

3. An initiation fee of \$250.00 will be charged to all new regular & associate memberships. (07/10)

4. Junior members promoting to regular membership do not pay the initiation fee.

5. All new memberships will pay a prorated annual membership fee of **\$11.00 per full month remaining through the next June 30.** (01/2026)

This is a \$30.00 dues increase for all regular club members. Life members are unaffected. Members will still be eligible for the \$80.00 work credit and retains the automatic work credit for all members over the age of 75. It has been 16 years since the last dues change and the \$30.00 increase works out to an additional \$2.50 per month for each member. We anticipate annual revenue will increase by \$10,000.
