



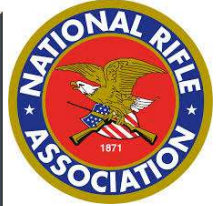

## RANGE H UPDATE

Range H has been opened to the membership. There are movable target frames you can stick in the ground but these frames ***must*** be placed at the base of the berms. Please look at the angle of bullet hitting your target and ensure the projectile will impact the berm. Due to the slight incline grading of the ranges, you can possibly skip a bullet up and over the berm if your shots are not impacting the back berm. Heath Gebhart acquired large wooden spools to keep your guns and equipment off the ground. These are not shooting tables and are not to be used as such. The additional sod has been placed on the remaining 2 side berms. Thanks to all the volunteers that have been utilizing the water tank daily to keep the new grass alive. Keep TRPC safe!

**The Tallahassee Rifle and Pistol Club Board of Directors propose, the following action in regards to the TRPC Standing Rules: Amending Tallahassee Rifle & Pistol Club Standing Rules to reflect an increase of the annual dues from \$180.00 to \$210.00.**

2. Regular membership fees are **\$210.00 per year**. (01/2026)

• Members will receive an \$80.00 credit for providing **2 hours** of range service. (01/2026)

• Range service hours must be provided at a Workday or approved by the Board of Directors. • See Range Service Policy. **or TRPC Website, Members Only Section, Club Policies.**

3. An initiation fee of \$250.00 will be charged to all new regular & associate memberships. (07/10)

4. Junior members promoting to regular membership do not pay the initiation fee.

5. All new memberships will pay a prorated annual membership fee of **\$11.00 per full month remaining through the next June 30**. (01/2026)
