

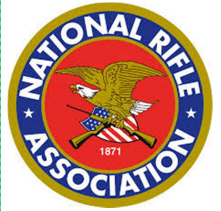

Greetings TRPC Members. I am pleased to serve as your new VP and am looking forward to keeping Our Club a safe, attractive and fun shooting environment for our members and guests. Our organization is 100% member run and managed and of course that means we all try to keep our property in great condition largely through member effort. Member work days are held the 5th Saturday, four times per year. The April work day was highly effective, and we have another work day this month on July 30. Keeping with tradition, this will be a shortened effort due to our summer heat and there will be no lunch. Plenty of sports drinks and water will be available however. Look for assignments in the WORK DAY section.

Match Directors: Thank you for serving. If you have ideas for improving your match, or need maintenance or repairs to equipment or your ranges, let's talk. We have planned improvements to NRA Action and Sporting Clays in the upcoming months. Our matches bring guests to our facility who have an avowed interest in the gun sports and that is a good thing for our Club.

Range policies are available on the website, at the front gate and at the Clubhouse. Renewal is upon us and now is a good time to refresh your memory on what is appropriate and inappropriate activity on our ranges. One thing that needs to be pointed out is that penetrator, or "green tip" ammo is not permitted on steel anywhere on the range. Also, hypervelocity handgun rounds, such as 5.57 should never be fired at our plates or within the arcade. These ultra high speed rounds are lots of fun, but may damage expensive steel targets. Also, when shot at steel they are also a fire hazard as our ranges dry out in summer heat. Paper only please!

Prescriptive burn update: The long dry days of summer are here and needless to say there will be no controlled burning for the near future. This is a weather and manpower logistics problem and will be solved and hopefully soon. In the meantime the fire lanes will continue to be maintained and brush and fuel will be removed from proximity to structures and storage buildings.

I hope everyone has a great summer and can enjoy our ranges during the longer days. Be safe and shoot straight!

Scrap wood and chloroplast go in designated area - DO NOT place in dumpster

Ranges A1 thru F - police for brass and trash/debris, empty garbage cans, sweep/blow

Range C - brush removal from berms -east and west

Member materials needed: pole saws, limb loppers, pitchforks. A trailer will be furnished to haul debris to a proper disposal site.

Range G - general cleanup and BMP work

pick up wads

empty trash cans

load house for ATA

Remove brush, straw and weeds from around pump house.

Remove straw from pump house roof

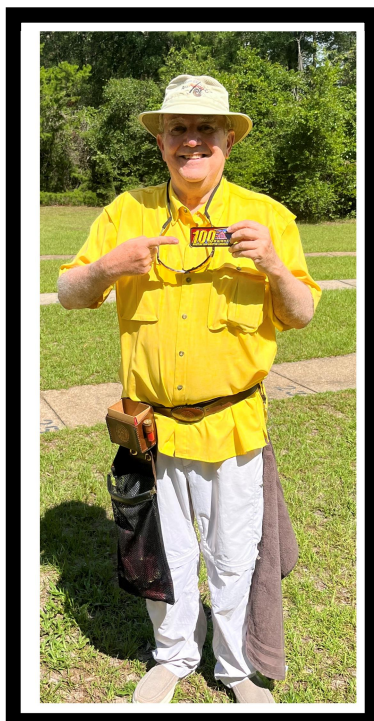
Clean up club house / Latrine duty
