

## **MESSAGE FROM THE VICE PRESIDENT**

The summer is winding down and the heat will soon start to fad. The Boy Scout Fun Shoot is coming up October 6th. This year the Sea Cadets and the Civil Air Patrol will also be joining us. We should have a bigger showing than the past few years. You can earn your service credit by volunteering to help at this event. We also have the Girl Scouts set up to shoot at TRPC for the 2nd ever sanctioned Girl Scout shooting event in the state of Florida on January 12, 2019. The improvements to the D range are completed along with the sidewalk connecting C and D ranges. We now have 3 ranges that are wheelchair accessible to the bathrooms. Stay tuned as more improvements are still to come.

Membership is currently at 382 and our finances look good. The club currently has more money in the bank than we did in 2009 at this same point in the year. During the past 9 years, the club has experienced quite a few improvements: automated gate, new roofs on all shelters, 2 ballistic walls, Cowboy town, Handicap bathrooms, sidewalks, air conditioned clubhouse, 22 high velocity fans, new road sign, 2 new Marquis's, new signage everywhere, 2 new storage trailers, parking corral for cowboy action, all new trauma kits, another AED, steel plate house & Texas Star permanently set up and 6 new concrete shooting benches on D range. With all of these improvements, our financial reserves are still strong enough to support the club.
